

CV Georg Stüssi

Georg Stüssi received his medical degree from the University of Zürich. He first worked in transplantation immunology looking at the impact of the ABO system in hematopoietic stem cell transplantation. He then obtained his clinical formation in Internal medicine and Hematology at the Kantonsspital Baden and the University Hospitals in Zürich and Basel and worked as a senior physician in Zürich. In 2010 he obtained habilitation at the University of Zürich. In 2011 he was appointed as the head of hematology at the Oncology Institute of Southern Switzerland and in 2015 as the head of the hematology laboratory of the hospital structure. He served as the president of the Swiss leukemia research group and as an expert for laboratory hematology. He has a long-standing research interest in hematopoietic stem cell transplantation and leukemia treatment and is the head of the cellular therapy program in Ticino.

He currently is professor of hematology at the University of Southern Switzerland and President of the Swiss Cancer League.
