PD Dr Anastasios Stathis MD, is a staff medical oncologist head of the New Drugs Development Unit and Chair of Clinical Research at the Oncology Institute of Southern Switzerland, Ospedale San Giovanni, Bellinzona, Switzerland. Dr Stathis earned his medical degree from the University of Pavia, Pavia, Italy, in 2003, before completing a specialty degree in oncology at the University of Insubria, Varese, Italy, in 2007. During his postgraduate training, Dr Stathis was a fellow in medical oncology at the Oncology Institute of Southern Switzerland, and a fellow in the Drug Development Program, at Princess Margaret Hospital, University of Toronto, in Toronto, Canada.

Dr Stathis has served as Principal Investigator and Co-Investigator for several clinical trials focusing on haematological malignancies and on drug development (mainly phase I studies). To date, he has received several awards for his work including the American Society of Clinical Oncology (ASCO) Merit Award and the Novartis Oncology Young Canadian Investigator Award (NOYCIA) in 2009 and the Pfizer Research Award in Oncology.

Dr Stathis is a member of the European Society of Medical Oncology (ESMO) since 2007, of the American Society of Clinical Oncology (ASCO) since 2008 and of the American Association for Cancer Research (AACR) since 2018. He is a member (since 2011) and Vice President (since 2016) of the New Drugs Working Group of the Swiss Group for Clinical Cancer Research (SAKK).

Dr Stathis has published extensively in peer-reviewed journals including Annals of Oncology, Clinical Cancer Research, Nature Reviews Clinical Oncology, Cancer Discovery and others and has authored several book chapters.
