Curriculum vitae



Georg Stüssi studied medicine in Zürich, Munich and Granada and graduated at University of Zürich in 1998. After graduation he started to work in Laboratory for Transplantation Immunology looking at the ABO system in hematopoietic stem cell transplantation and attended the postgraduate course for experimental medicine. He received his clinical formation in Internal medicine and Hematology at the Kantonsspital Baden and the University Hospitals in Zürich and Basel. He achieved the specialization in Internal Medicine in 2005 and in hematology in 2008 and was appointed Privatdozent from the University Zürich in 2010. His main activities in hematology are laboratory hematology including immunophenotyping, hematopoietic stem cell transplantation, and treatment of acute and chronic leukemias. Georg Stüssi is member of the leukemia project group of the SAKK and the HOVON-SAKK study group. He is author and coauthor of more than 50 articles in the field of clinical and diagnostic hematology. His current research activities are focused on the treatment of acute myeloid leukemia. Since 2011, he is the head of the hematology division at the Oncology Institute of Southern Switzerland. Since 2013 he is head of the SAKK leukemia research group of Switzerland.
